## Champagne

### **Champagne Pierre Paillard**

In 1768, Antoine Paillard purchased a few acres in Bouzy in the heart of the Champagne region of France. 8 generations later, these wines have become not only some of the most value driven bottlings in the region but also some of the most beautifully made. All the wines are crafted from fruit grown in Grand Cru rated vineyards, the highest level of production, and meticulously aged in their 19th century cellars. Father Benoit and his 2 sons Antoine and Quentin now oversee the house and the winemaking.

**'Les Mottelettes', Blanc de Blancs 2010** **\$130**

**'Les Maillerettes', Blanc de Noirs 2010** **\$130**

Since 2007 these 2 single vineyard bottlings have been showing the purity of their respective varieties. They are vineyards known as 'mother plots,' because the fruit is so revered that they use cuttings from them to plant new plots. The blanc de blancs is classic chardonnay with green apple and lemon creme, and the blanc de noirs shows white cherry and almond blossom notes with a pie crust like yeasty finish.

**'Les Terres Roses', Grand Cru, Rosé, NV** **\$115**

A higher percentage of chardonnay gives this rose a natural citrus lift while the addition of barrel aged pinot noir to the blend brings a hint of cinnamon to the cranberry and pomegranate flavors. Medium bodied and with well-balanced dryness.

# WHITE WINES

## FRANCE

### Loire Valley

#### **Alphonse Mellot**

The Mellot family has a long and storied history in winemaking that dates to the 16th century. Local records name the family as vine growers and wine merchants in documents from 1513; in 1698, César Mellot was appointed Wine Advisor to Louis XIV. Then at the beginning of the 19th century, Alphonse Mellot opened a tavern in Sancerre, where one could enjoy a selection of local wines. In 1881, he was granted a license to ship his wine throughout France and all over the world. The rest, you could say, is history.

#### **Alphonse Mellot, Sauvignon Blanc, 'La Moussiere,' Sancerre 2015** **\$70**

Named for the Domaine de la Moussiere which is the cornerstone of their house, it is made from mostly younger vines and is the most crisp and citrusy of the lineup.

#### **Alphonse Mellot, Sauvignon Blanc, 'Generation XIX,' Sancerre 2013** **\$145**

Name for the celebration of the 19th generation of Mellot winemakers, this is made from 87-year-old vines and is the smallest production. The wine spends a year in large oak barrels but does not show overt oaky flavors but instead layers of toasted almond and meyer lemon with a citrus pith dry finish

#### **Alphonse Mellot, Sauvignon Blanc, 'Edmond,' Sancerre 2014** **\$150**

The richest and most powerful of the trio, 'Edmond' is from the same vineyard parcel as the others but is aged entirely in smaller oak barrels, with about 60% new. Lively and bright but with a rich weight.

### Meursault

#### Domaine des Comtes Lafon

When Jules Lafon married Marie Boch in 1894, their union came with vineyard holdings from her family in Meursault. It would be 2 more generations until the domaine would come to prominence when Rene Lafon came back from Paris and set about replanting and reconditioning the vineyards that had been controlled by sharecroppers. In 1984, Dominique Lafon took the reins and in 1987 he began to regain the family vineyards from his grandfather's leases. Dominique is one of the most significant and respected winemakers in Burgundy and he has helped to change the landscape both in France as well as abroad. His wines are always incredibly nuanced and textured with a balance of acidity and minerality that speaks to the vineyards themselves.

### Alsace

#### **Trimbach**

The Trimbach family dates to the year 1626 in Ribeauvillé, Alsace. They are considered as one of the most elegant and pristine producers of terroir driven wines in the world. Currently on the 13th generation of family winemakers and continuing to produce mind bending examples of Alsatian varietals. The Cuvée Frédéric Emile has been produced since 1967 and is listed in every French Michelin three-star restaurant. The Clos Sainte Hune is considered by many enthusiasts as the "Montrachet of Alsace". In any case, these are all prime examples of how terroir can be showcased in a bottle of wine in a manner of which to make you smile with every taste.

#### **Trimbach, Riesling, 'Frédéric Emile' 2009** **\$150**

Named after Frédéric who became famous for providing a guarantee for quality. The marl-limestone-sandstone and fossil flecked soil lend this wine a remarkable personality.

#### **Trimbach, Riesling, 'Geisberg,' Grand Cru 2009** **\$185**

The First Grand Cru of Trimbach which was released as the 2009 vintage. With just over 5 acres' total production area, this offering from Trimbach is extremely rare and proves to be a great example of how Grand Cru Riesling from Alsace is truly mesmerizing with its showcase of minerality.

#### **Trimbach, Riesling, 'Clos Sainte Hune,' Grand Cru 2007** **\$540**

This exceptional wine is a product of the terroir of the Rosacker vineyard and has been part of the Trimbach family for more than 200 years. The family keeps the bottle 5 years in the cellar before release. Very tight mineral notes with mint, lime, white flowers and truffle notes.

# United States

## **The Pinot Noirs of Lingua Franca- A life time's search comes to fruition in the Willamette Valley**

I cannot think of a wine that means more to me personally than the wines being crafted at Lingua Franca in the Eola- Amity Hills AVA in Willamette Valley of Oregon. I consider myself lucky beyond words to have been able to work with Master Sommelier Larry Stone at Rubicon restaurant in San Francisco for 5 extraordinary years, learning more than I ever could have imagined from his mentorship. Larry started his wine making venture with a label called 'Sirita,' named for his daughter Siri and made with Kathy Corison at her winery in Napa. He went on to explore the potential of different properties in the Red Mountain AVA in Washington State before he started working for Evening Land Vineyards where they had an amazing vineyard called 'Seven Springs.' It just so happened that the property across the road became available and after Evening Land passed on the opportunity to purchase the land, Larry was contacted by the owners who asked if he would be interested himself. After more than a decade of looking for the perfect site, the universe opened the door for what would become Larry Stone Vineyards and Lingua Franca. Larry brought in the extremely talented Thomas Savre and the amazing Dominique Lafon joined on as well. 2015 is the first vintage of the estate wines as well as the bottlings from vineyards he has come to know and respect- the stories of those that helped bring this dream to fruition, both with their selfless hard work as well as those that grow the grapes, are told below with Larry's personal descriptions.

### **ANVI, Eola-Amity Hills 2015 \$85**

"AVNI is a Stone family name and means 'rock' or 'stone.' This pinot reflects the complex flavor profile of the Eola-Amity hills fruit, born of volcanic soils on hillside vineyards and sourced primarily from our neighbors in Hopewell. The wine is medium bodied with floral, mineral and red cherry and black plum fruit tones as a long silky finish."

### **Joshua, Junichi and Siri, Ribbon Ridge 2015 \$105**

"This cuvée is named in honor of three people who volunteered to help us through our first harvest and whose dedication made possible these wines. We name this Ribbon Ridge cuvée in their honor because of the hard work taken in sorting this fruit picked from the same vineyard on the same day from a hail-damaged site. The fruit was harvested from the same vineyard on the same day, but about 50% of the fruit has been rigorously sorted and then fermented whole cluster, and the remaining clusters were individually inspected, trimmed by hand or discarded before being destemmed and fermented separately.

### **Ryan's Plow, Willamette Valley 2015 \$125**

"Ryan's Plow is comprised of the fruit from two vineyards that the talented viticulturist from Australia, Ryan Hannaford, farmed for several years before we came on the scene. He worked with Dominique Lafon at Evening Land where he developed a deep understanding of organic and biodynamic farming practices. He was generous in finding fruit sources for us in our first year. Both vineyards are located on prime Jory/Nekia soils, one in Dundee (Black Walnut) and the other next door to Lingua Franca (Seven Springs). The Seven Springs fruit is the Calera Clone and we fermented that partially whole cluster, having to cut each bunch in half by hand at the sorting table, with the shoulders being destemmed and the "hens and chicks" tip of the clusters being thrown into the tank in alternating layers with the destemmed fruit. Lots of work! The fruit from Black Walnut was very easy to sort and it was mainly destemmed, being comprised of PN115 and Pommard clones. This was also one of the earliest cuvées to come together."

### **Mimi's Mind, Eola-Amity Hills 2015 \$185**

"Mimi Casteel's beautifully maintained vineyard is a product of her creative and unique farming practices. However, they are grounded in a very thoughtful--philosophical and scientific--study of natural farming practices that include Biodynamic and organic, but escape any single categorization. You may see her pruning in winter while her dwarf sheep, herded by a prized lama, are keeping the flowers and grasses around the vineyard trimmed. The balance of life in her vineyard is obvious to anyone open to the natural world around, with little apparent intervention necessary on her part, except to provide the minimal amount of spraying required to fight fungus in a wet year. We love the example this vineyard sets for us, because it is just above the town on Hopewell, sloping to the east, and has a little wash of Woodburn soils at the bottom of the vineyard that graduate up into Nekia and Jory—similar to the situation at Lingua Franca. We hope to learn from her example. This is the finest expression of our series of wines this year. Deeply flavored with complex interplay of mineral, floral and fruit elements, with spice, truffles, savory herbs and 'tension' so important to a vibrant wine. The finish goes on and carries the complex of flavors to the end, diminishing ever so slowly. It is a wine to contemplate.

## PINOT NOIR

### Peay Vineyards

One day, about 13 years ago at our tasting group in San Francisco, a sandy haired guy walked in with a huge grin and a bottle of wine. Many Saturdays later, we found out Andy Peay was starting his own winery when he brought in an unlabeled bottle for us to try and we all went gaga for it. 'Wait what? Are you serious?,' I asked as we kept smelling the chardonnay in our glass, trying to grasp that we had never even thought to ask where Andy showed up from, we just loved having him in the group and the friendship we had all formed. He told us that in 1996 he and his brother Nick had bought an old sheep ranch and apple farm on the Sonoma Coast and amidst the fog and Pacific Ocean breezes, they decided to plant grapes and see how the journey that brought them together would turn out. We learned about his partner in crime and brother Nick the winegrower, who worked before, during, and after schooling at Schramsberg, La Jota, Newton, and as assistant wine maker at Storrs in the Santa Cruz Mountains as well as their winemaker Vanessa Wong who had become the third part of family as well as Nick's wife. She joined Peay Vineyards for their first vintage in 2001 after her tenure as winemaker at Peter Michael Winery as well as time working in France at Château Lafite-Rothschild in Pauillac and Domaine Jean Gros in Vosne-Romanée as well as in California at Hirsch Winery and Franciscan. Peay has played a very large part in the story of my career as I have watched their wines gain the amazing attention they deserve and I have been so fortunate to support them along the way. They now find a new home at Mirabelle and I could not be more thrilled to continue the story!

#### Ama 2013

\$130

In the Kashaya language of the Pomo people, Ama means "land or place," and Pomo thrived in this region of the Pacific Coast for millennia. This blend is often bright, floral, earthy and non-fruit oriented and fits in between the muscle of Pomarium and the intellect of Scallop Shelf with aromas of cherries, minerals, spice and a touch of smoke.

#### Pomarium 2014

\$140

Pomarium is Latin for apple orchard and the vineyard was once planted to acres of apple trees; some for eating, some for drying, some for making cider. It is the more broad-shouldered, masculine cuvee and the fruit flavors lean to dark berry and plum notes with a fuller mouth feel and an earthy finish redolent of the surrounding forests

#### Scallop Shelf 2013

\$145

The Pomo names the knoll that the vineyards lie on 'where scallops lie,' and indeed their hilltop was a former sea bed uplifted about 5-7 million years ago along the neighboring San Andreas Fault which created the bedrock of the Pacific Coast Ridges 250 million years ago. This is the most feminine of the blends with notes of dried roses, cherry blossoms and jasmine tea followed by pomegranate and orange rind on the nose to provide lift and prettiness.
